

10-8 Pistol Test #1: Single Target Speed Standards

Revision 5

Par Time:

Par time is the same for all strings. Choose 5, 6.5, or 8 seconds. Score is reported together with par time.

Scoring:

All strings are fired on an IDPA target at 7 yards. Target is scored 1 point per hit in the -0 zone on the head (6" square) or torso (8" circle). Hits anywhere else are not scored.

Start positions:

From duty/tactical holster - long gun ready or interview position (hands touching in front).
From concealment - hands naturally at sides.
